

Don't know your ring size? Help is here!

1. PRINT THIS PAGE. Make sure the page scaling in your print dialog box is set to "do not scale".
2. CONFIRM. Measure this bar:
It must be exactly 2" long. If it is not 2" long, return to step one.
3. CUT IT OUT. Carefully cut along the outline of the ring sizer.
4. CUT A SLIT. On the line labled "slit".
5. WRAP IT AROUND. Wrap the sizer around your finger, push the tab through the slit and pull until it's snug. The number that lines up with the slit is your ring size.
6.THINGS TO CONSIDER:
-A very wide ring may need to be a half or full size larger to fit on your fingerSome knuckles are bigger than others. Use your judgment on whether you'll need a larger sizeFingers are smaller when they're cold, and bigger when they're warm.
